The Newtown Forest Association's (NFA) will honor Earth Day by inviting everyone willing and able to help the NFA conduct a Trail Clean Up and Preserve Restoration at our NETTLETOWN PRESERVE on Saturday May 1st, 2010. This is a continuation of past Earth Day Projects at the most photographed spot in Newtown overlooking the flagpole and church steeples.

**You can and will make a difference.** This work day will prune the overhanging privet and limbs from the trails, repair wet trail areas, remove invasive species, mulch existing plantings and flower beds and remove fallen sticks, logs and debris.

Our plan is to meet on Old Castle Drive (off Castle Hill Road) at the Preserve between 10:00AM. The NFA will be supplying bottled water for the volunteers as well as basic first aid should the need arise. We will have limited yard tools available, accordingly we ask that you bring your own tools (just in case we run out) such as pruning clippers, lop shears, bow saws, rakes, and wheel barrows. All children must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
